### RULES FOR CAMPERS UNDER 18

Welcome, families! We are glad to have you here. For your children's safety, remember that the Ale is not certified as a children's camp, nor is it childproof. Your children could easily get hurt or lost if not closely supervised. The camp environment is also fragile-- please help your children respect and care for the trees, plants, and paths.

- A. Campers under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, who is responsible for those children at all times. A Statement of Responsibility form must be signed by the child's parent or the appointed guardian, and provided to the Ale on or before arrival at camp.
- B. Parents who send their child to camp with a guardian must also sign a form authorizing emergency medical treatment.
- C. There will be a designated cabin for teenage girls. It is not appropriate for boys to be in or around this cabin. There will be a designated area for teens to mingle.
- D. There will be a designated cabin for teenage boys. It is not appropriate for girls to be in or around this cabin. There will be a designated area for teens to mingle.
- E. Campers under 18 will remain in or near the main camp area.
- F. The illegal use and sale of alcohol and drugs is prohibited.
- G. If applicable, posted waterfront rules must be followed. Please review them with your children. MWMA, Inc. does not assume responsibility for campers swimming.
